CONCEPT NOTE

The scope of social media in the third decade of the twenty first century has far exceeded its initial vision of simply offering people inter-connectivity. Today social media not only connects friends, family members, colleagues and old batchmates but it also affects the larger domain of public opinion, targeted advertisement, news, entertainment, social organisation and cultural practices. This period is radically different from the social climate of the pre-social media times when the academic system and the many cultures associated with it had developed- the period during which a majority of the current teachers received their education. Intention of survival necessitates quick adaptation to the changing times and the academic world is doing the same. Most of the current faculty members and university administrators are active on social media albeit their point of view may be different from a student who has been on social media from a much younger age. The young minds of our students have formed within the climate of social media, a phenomenon which needs to be understood for better functioning of the academic institutions. This webinar seeks to explore the impact of social media on the mind, behavior and beliefs of the students who receive higher education in colleges and universities. The purpose would be to arrive at an understating of the pros and cons of social media and how the various platforms can be used to facilitate academic practices.
